






Tom Stathis brought his very popular switching puzzle module. Here are 3 views of the module along with Tom and a young fellow exercising his switching skills.

On Saturday I attended, along with Ron Christensen, MMR and his wife, the National Insulator Association (NIA) National Convention Show. This year their National Convention was held in Elkhart, Indiana. The show featured many displays and about 120 tables of items for sale. Interest included telephone. electrician, railroad and other hobbvists' collections. Wires along the railroad right of way played an important role for railroads for many years including controls for signals, telegraph and telephone communications and other uses. Many companies manufactured telegraph and telephone products specifically for the railroads. Along with those products pole lines were installed to support the equipment and glass, porcelain and other materials were used to insulate the wires from the supporting structures. Some railroads even had identifying marks displayed on their insulators. Below are two examples: one from the Pennsylvania railroad and one from the Canadian Pacific Railroad. Bottom is a photo from a typical NIA show.
