

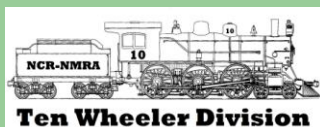

Clinic Schedule Update

Selecting Industries for Your Model Railroad: This 60 minute presentation is designed to help model railroaders select industries and community businesses for their model railroads through a systematic approach.
